RSMC Fight Back

Priority will be given to RSMC members.

The main objectives of this course are:

- To build confidence to act and support for RSMC goals and objectives through negotiations
- To develop workplace and community organizing and communication skills
- To develop a local fight back plan in support of RSMCs
- To share ways to stay informed

Temporary Workers & Their Rights

Priority will be given to Temporary members.

At the end of this course the participants should:

- Understand their basic rights under the collective agreement.
- Have a general understanding of how the Union works and how to get involved.
- Have some knowledge of the Union's history and orientation.

Social Stewards

This course trains members to be social stewards. Social stewards are resource people who assist co-workers experiencing personal problems. They listen to members, help them identify their concerns and find solutions, and refer them to appropriate resources.

Human Rights

Equality is not only an issue for the CUPW-STTP equity seeking groups. It is also an issue for women and it is an issue of *class*.

We will also be referring to the collective agreement, constitution, human rights code and the United Nations Universal declaration on Human rights.
