How to Write a "RESOLUTION"

Be clear and concise in stating what led you to write for action or change (contact, constitution, etc.) The more precise your statement is, the more likely that your resolution will be passed.

The following, "Whereas," are where you would define the problem as a statement of conditions or situations. Depending on the issue, you may have one or more whereas:

Whereas [define the problem]' and,
Whereas [define the problem]' and,
Whereas [define the problem]' and,

After stating the, "whereas," you would state the, "Be it Resolved," which should define the Action and Solution to the above conditions. Again, as with the "Whereas," you could have more than one resolve; however, each resolve should define one action or solution:

Be it resolved [define the action and solution]; and,
Be if further resolved [define the action and solution]; and,
Be it further resolved [define the action and solution]; and,
Be it finally resolved [define the action and solution].

A resolution needs to be moved by the author and seconded by another member, before being voted on at the RSMC meeting March 21st 6pm for RSMC demands or April 1st 10am for Urban demands. ** any questions, please call us or ask a shop steward.
